GOAL OF THE INTERNATIONAL ULTRASOUND COURSE

BEGINNERS' COURSE

After having completed the beginners' course, the participants should be able to perform routine musculoskeletal ultrasound and recognize common pathology in PRM and sports medicine. An experienced sonographer first demonstrates the examination of the normal joint. Participants then perform ultrasound themselves under the supervision of experienced teachers. Each session is concluded with a lecture on common pathology of the joint and periarticular soft tissues.

The first day will be devoted to the examination of shoulder (morning) and elbow (afternoon). Hip and knee (day 2), wrist and hand, ankle and foot (day 3), and nerve visualisation (day 4) will be addressed in the same way. New during this edition will be the section pathology with patients on Friday afternoon.

We also offer a lecture dedicated to interventional US.

SATELLITE COURSES

On Thursday, a workshop on US-guided botulin toxin infiltrations is scheduled. On Friday a workshop on US-guided infiltration techniques and on platelet-rich-plasma (PRP) infiltrations will be organised for more experienced sonographers. After having completed this workshop, the participants should be able to use US as a tool for intramuscular and intra-articular infiltrations.
